Choose one piece of homework each week from Topic or Science. Be as creative and as imaginative as you can!

Draw and colour a picture of an Anglo-Saxon. What is he/she wearing? (You will need to research this first).

Explain how life in the Anglo Saxon times was different to today.

Create your own Sutton Hoo helmet/mask using whatever materials you have. You could use cardboard or paper Mache for example. You could also decorate it using tin foil or buttons. Look at the one found at Sutton Hoo for an example. (It can be any size).

Design your own (realistic!) Anglo Saxon coin. Look on http://www.bbc.co.uk/history/trail/conquest/wessex_kings/coins_intro.shtml for ideas and designs.

Can you decipher the code? Can you write your teacher a message in futhark?

You are an archaeologist who has dug up a box of Anglo Saxon artefacts. What could be inside? Describe in a diary entry, using adjectives and similes what you found.



Create a 'Wanted Poster, which includes a description of the criminal, states what crime has been committed and what the punishment is. Look at this website for ideas.

Year 4 Homework : Electricity

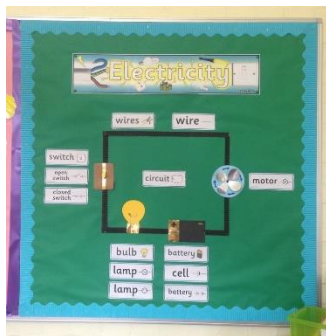
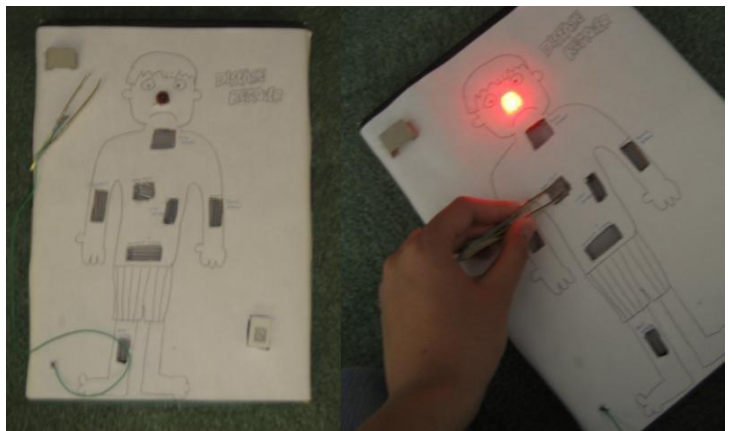
Choose one/two pieces of work each week.
