<p><u>Get Creative!</u> Create a globe for the world, Europe or the UK out of recyclable materials.</p> 	<p><u>Maths</u> Write a list of distances from one place or country to another.</p> <p>For example: The distance from England to France is 20.6 miles.</p> 	<p><u>English</u> Write a description of your own Beast / Monster. Include adjectives to give more detail.</p> <p>Think about colour, size, shape and what it can do. Include as much detail as you can. Include a picture to show your design.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> Fill a quarter of a small empty water bottle with soil and then the rest of the bottle with water. Shake it well and leave to stand for a few days. What do you notice? What different layers can you see? Draw what you see and write down sentences to describe what you have observed.</p>
<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Use natural materials to create a Stone Age picture. Create types of paint by crushing berries, grass leaves and other natural materials.</p>	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>Create your own tool from the Bronze Age. Think carefully about which materials you will use, how you can cut and shape materials and decorate it effectively.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Make a collage out of rocks. You could arrange the rocks on the ground to make a picture and photograph to bring into school.
