CAMERA ENFORCEMENT CAR

Please note that the camera enforcement car was around the school area this week. The camera enforcement car will monitor zigzag markings on school streets, where illegal parking can put the safety of others at risk and cause unnecessary congestion.



Anyone found parking illegally by the new camera will be issued with a £70 fixed penalty notice, or a warning notice if the restrictions are newly established. Parents and carers, please be mindful of where you stop or park your car when doing the school runs. On Latimer Street, once you pass the speed bump near the gate, those zig-zag markings are active, you must not stop or park there at all.

SCHOOL MEALS

Please remember to book and pay for school meals using ParentPay **one week in advance**. **Kindly note that Chartwells will only supply meals that have been pre-booked and paid for.**

The cut-off day for making the bookings is every Sunday so please set a reminder for yourself to avoid disappointment. For children in receipt of free school meals, parents do not need to pay however, the meal choices need to be made and booked according to your child's preference. **Please ensure the chosen meals are ones your child enjoys and will eat, as children often do not enjoy meals selected for them.**

Please also make note of Chartwell's cancellation policy: **Sickness** - The parent needs to call the Chartwells Customer Care Line on **0781 894 4478** before **9am** every day of the child's sickness. A credit is given from the second day onwards. Schools' trips and other cancellations – 48 hours' notice before 9am prior to the event the parent needs to call the Chartwells Customer Care Line in order for the meal to be cancelled and a credit given.

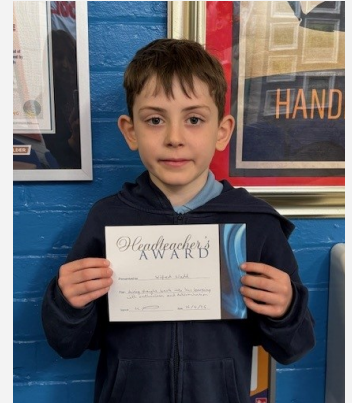
WEEKLY HEADTEACHER AWARDS

For showing more independence in his learning this year.



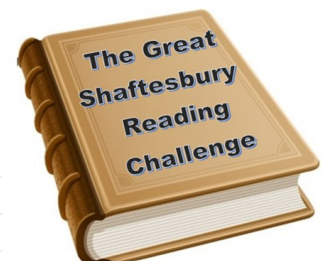
