ROAD SAFETY

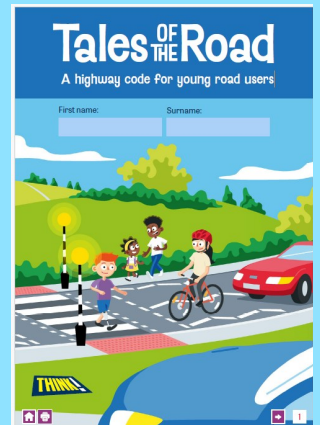
Each family at Shaftesbury will have received a copy of the booklet - **TALES OF THE ROAD** which has been sent home with the children today.

It is a highway code for young road users and a useful guide to keeping yourself and others safe on the road.

The contents include guidelines on walking, cycling, scooting, rollerblading, skating, riding in cars or buses, traffic lights, road markings and signals. The booklet also contains a workbook which can be navigated by children.

A PDF version is also available and has been emailed out to all parents and carers.

Please browse through the booklet with your children as it is a very useful and educational resource for road safety.



YEAR 5 BIKEABILITY

Leicester Bikeability are in school for 2 weeks for free cycle training with the Year 5 children. The ability to cycle safely should be considered an essential for any child – it is a skill which will last for their whole life and is especially important. Bikeability Level 2 aims to develop riders' skills and confidence for cycling on single-lane roads and simple junctions with mostly moderate traffic flows and prepares riders for cycling on more complex, often busier or faster roads and junctions.

Class 5G had the opportunity to train this week and 5P will be training next week.

The weather has been ideal for it and children really enjoyed cycling around!

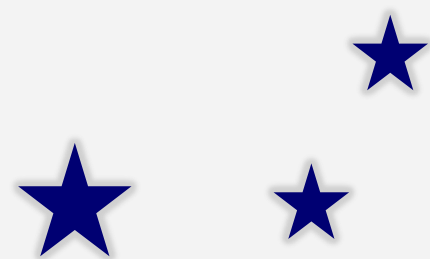
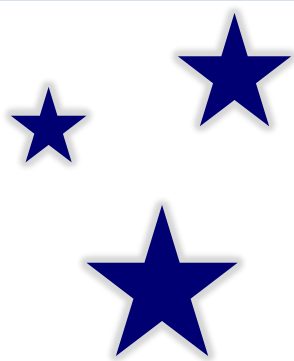

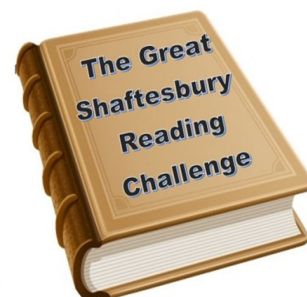
