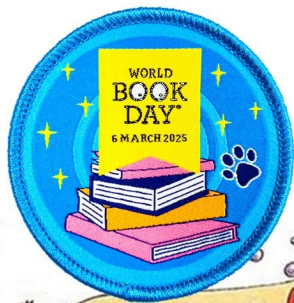


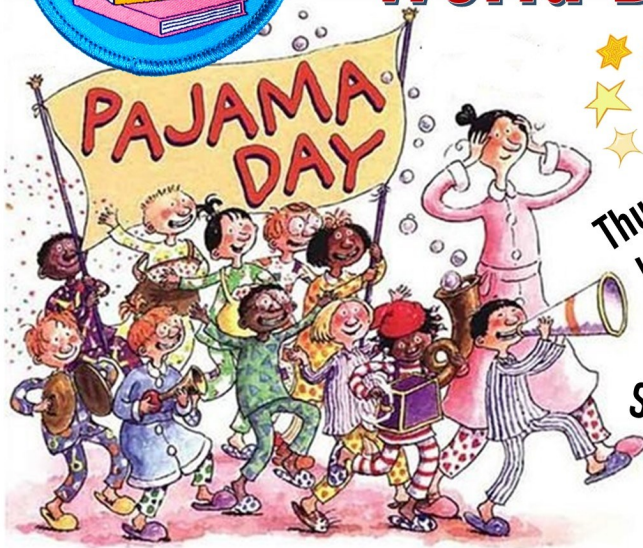

In fact, a third of the food we grow is thrown away. This is not just a waste of the food but also the energy and water that it took to grow it. 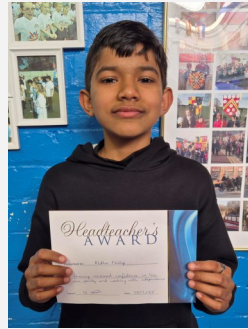

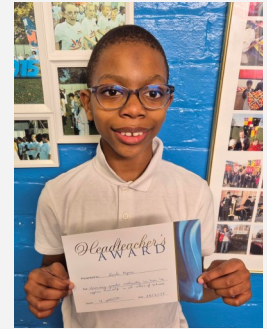
WEEKLY HEADTEACHER AWARDS

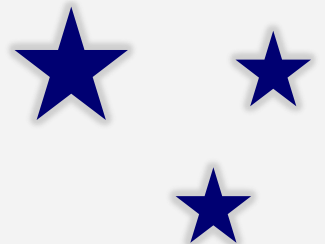
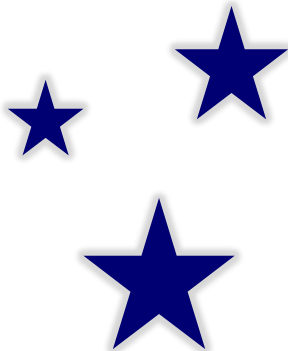
