SEASONAL FLU IMMUNISATION

The immunisation team were in school on Monday to administer flu vaccines to all those children who were registered for it.

If any parents/ carers missed the opportunity to register, a second opportunity will be offered (**Not in school**).

This will be either at a **Community Pharmacy** (Flu nasal vaccine) or **Clinic** (Flu injection).

How to give consent for your child to get the flu vaccination:

Make a note of the **code for our school LE120026** and visit www.leicsandrutlandimms.co.uk

Select Seasonal Flu and enter the school code.

On the consent declaration page you can consent for either the nasal flu vaccine or the injectable flu vaccine.

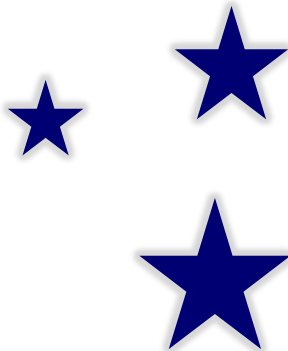
