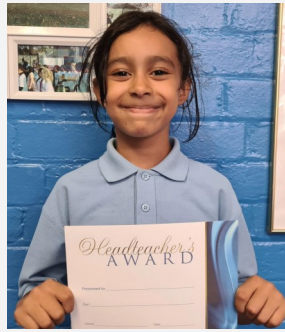

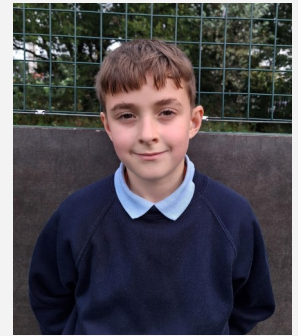
WEEKLY HEADTEACHER AWARDS

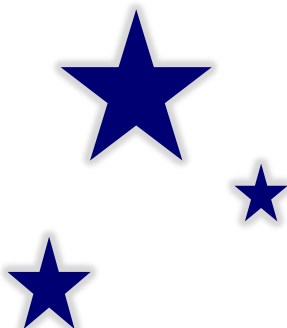

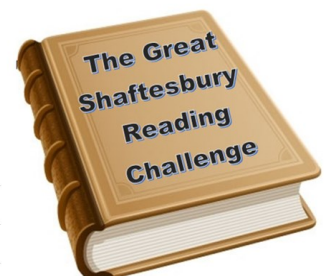
