### AFTER SCHOOL CARE

Parents and carers are kindly requested to book and pay in advance on ParentPay if they would like their child to attend the after school care club. In emergency, bookings can be made on the same day but please inform the office staff on the day. The staff will then update the register and also inform the child (The bookings on the system are not constantly monitored during the day). Registers are usually prepared first thing in the morning and your child's name may be missed off if parents have made a late booking. Please also note that cancellations must be made 24 hours in advance on ParentPay. If there are any same day cancellations, please inform the office or the after school care members of staff. Thank you for your co-operation.

Please note that the **closing date** for secondary school applications is **31st October 2024**.

### YEAR 3 JUNIOR SCHOOL APPLICATIONS

The application process for Year 3 has opened online from **2nd September 2024**. Parents are now able to apply for their child's junior school place. Please note that the **closing date** for junior school applications is midnight on **Wednesday 15 January 2025**.

### SCHOOL MEALS

Please remember to book and pay for school meals using ParentPay **two weeks in advance**. The cut-off day for making the bookings is every Tuesday. For children in receipt of free school meals, parents do not need to pay however, the meals need to be booked.

**Please also make note of Chartwell's cancellation policy:**

**Sickness** - The parent needs to call the Chartwells Customer Care Line on **01908 615705** before **9am** every day of the child's sickness. A credit is given from the second day onwards. Schools' trips and other cancellations – 48 hours' notice before 9am prior to the event the parent needs to call the Chartwells Customer Care Line in order for the meal to be cancelled and a credit given.
