**REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY - 9TH NOVEMBER**

Remembrance Sunday is held in the United Kingdom as a day to commemorate the contribution of British and Commonwealth military and civilian servicemen and women in the two World Wars and later conflicts. Senior Members of The Royal Family will be joined by leading UK politicians, alongside representatives of the armed forces, Commonwealth nations, and faith communities, for the two-minute silence at 11am and the National Service of Remembrance.

Remembrance poppies are a traditional symbol of Remembrance Sunday; they may be worn individually on clothing, made into wreaths, or attached to small wooden picket crosses. These remembrance poppies are sold by the Royal British Legion to raise money for their charitable work helping the UK Armed Forces community.

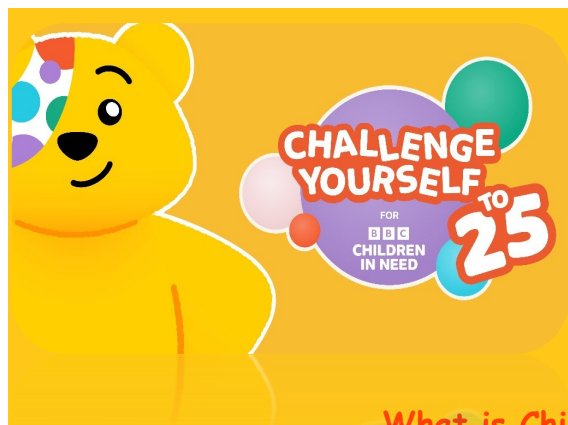

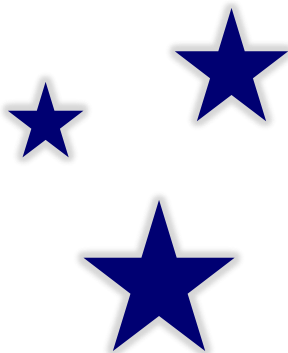

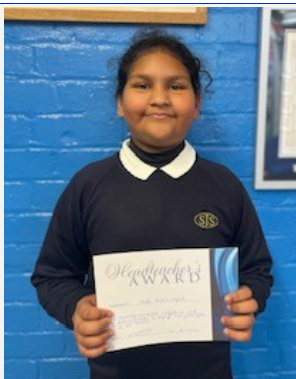
